Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® Program Contractor-Installed Emergency Measures and Rebates

The rebate options listed below are emergency measures based on the immediate need for primary home heating during the heating season. Where and if possible, the Program encourages customers to complete the non-emergency Program, which includes a comprehensive home energy assessment. The home energy assessment is intended to analyze the overall consumption of a home and provide a detailed report of the home's energy efficiency. The report also includes a list of recommended energy-saving improvements tailored specifically to the home. The energy assessment provides various free measures, which are installed by the energy auditor at the time of the home energy assessment.

Rebate Qualifications

- The new heating system must be installed between October 1st and March 31st.
- Participating contractor must install the new heating system.
- Installation of new heating system must occur within 48 hours of customer contacting the contractor.
- Successful test-out by a CLEAResult energy auditor must be performed prior to rebate payment.
- Rebate Application must be received by CLEAResult within ninety (90) days from the installation date of the new heating system.
